	6.4 The membership has grown tremendously. As at 12 <sup>th</sup> April 2012 membership stands at 1754. Alex thanked the members who recommended their friends and colleagues to join the Chapter and encouraged members to continue to bring in more PMI Global members to the Chapter.
	6.5 Alex thanked all past Executive Committee, SB Tan & Co for their accountant service and ieIDEAS for their secretariat support.
7	Treasurer's Report
	7.1 Jasmine presented the Treasurer's Report. The surplus was at \$\$466,480.96 as of December 2011.
	7.2 Jasmine highlighted that in Clause No 12.4 of the constitution states that "for any expenditure in excess of \$30,000 per month, Executive Committee shall get an approval from a subsequent General Meeting". As required by the Constitution, Jasmine requested for approval as during the course of the year, more than SGD 30,000 was spent in a month on three occasions to Resort World at Sentosa, all related to Symposium expenses.
	Senaka approved the cost expenditure, seconded by Ramesh Swaminathan.
	7.3 As no objections were raised by the members, the Treasurer Report was approved by Rajesh and seconded by Natarajan.
	7.4 A member highlighted that the constitution clause should be approval to be seek prior to the more than S\$30,000 spending. Umesh shared that proposal of constitution amendments would be shared to members upon consultation with the legal advisor. No objections were raised by the members.
	7.5 A member highlighted that the surplus presented did not tally with the Balance Sheet printout. Jasmine shared that the Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss was accurate, and was accepted by the members. Alex suggested that the Board review the cost and benefit of having external Auditor.
	Senaka proposed and seconded by Praveen, the new Board to determine and appoint an external auditor with due diligence if needed and communicate to the members. Objection was raised by 1 member.
	The AGM was hiatus as Mr. Anand Rao presented a talk on Social Media and Its Relevance In Project Management.
